# Principal's Message:

Dear Parents,

In this Hotline I want to recognize a few great Notre Dame School achievements. First, I want to thank our Fifth Grade teacher Stephanie Beyers for coaching our team in the Diocesan Religion Contest. NDS entered a team of 11 fifth and sixth graders into the contest with 22 other Sacramento Diocese elementary schools. At the end of the day our students came away with the Second Place trophy! Congratulations!

Last night's PTO meeting was very educational. Our PTO President Jean Hensley brought in a great speaker who talked about communication. I think everyone present took away good insights, but for me it boiled down to realizing that not everyone thinks like I do, and I need to listen to others better. I think that if we all did that alone, our communication would be much more productive.

We received our ITBS standardized test results from the tests we took earlier this year. Remember that we use the test as a diagnostic tool to measure retention from the previous year, and these results will drive our instruction. For example, if we find that there is a common area that students are falling short in, we will modify either the curriculum or the instruction to bring the students up. This is what we call using the test as a formative assessment. Today one of my teachers attended a webinar that focused on ways to use the data from the ITBS as a formative tool, and she will be sharing with our staff at next week's inservice.

I went to a girl's basketball game on Tuesday night at the NDS gym and I have to say I was very impressed with the talent and drive of the girls. Our seventh grade team is made up of all sixth grade girls and they outplayed Palermo from start to finish. I saw our kids pushing the ball up the court, playing great defense, and a general court sense that I would not have expected from 6<sup>th</sup> graders. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls' team played with the same intensity, even to the point of executing a great full court press.

Lastly I want to wish you a very nice Thanksgiving. My prayer is that we all reflect on what God has blessed us with and ask Him to give us a heart of gratitude, because our response is what matters. Seeing God in both triumphs and trials is to Answer the Call.
