The contract and first payment must be turned into the office by Sept. 3 or you will be charged at the drop-in rate.

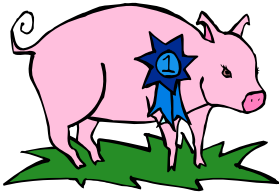
